Mr Goh became Executive Vice President Marketing and the Regions in June 2010. Prior to that he was President of Singapore Airlines Cargo for four years. His overseas assignments were in China and Scandinavia.

Mr Goh is Chairman of SilkAir and a Board Director of Mount Alvernia Hospital. He also serves on the Board of Advisors of the School of Information Systems at Singapore Management University.

in Computer Science & Engineering, Management Science and Cognitive Science, all from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology.
